

Personal Data Protection Regulations

On the Protection of Natural Persons in regard to the Processing of Personal Information and Data - Information Clause

In accordance with the provisions of Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the EU Council from 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the storing, processing and transfer of personal data, as well as repeal of the Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as the GDPR Regulation), we are legally obliged to inform you that:

- The administrator of your personal data is Kazimierz Wielki University with its office registered at ul. Chodkiewicza 30, 85-064 Bydgoszcz;
- Data Protection Officer supervising the correctness of personal data processing, who can be contacted via the following e-mail address: iod@ukw.edu.pl, has been appointed by the administrator of your personal data;
- Your personal data is processed in order to register your participation in the XIV International Conference: *Moulds and Mycotoxins*, communicate with participants in order to organize the scientific event, document its course, including preparation of a list of participants, issuing certificates of participation, preparation of the conference and post-conference materials, archival purposes, and, in the case of participant's consent, to receive information about conferences and events with a scientific profile or popularizing science organized by Kazimierz Wielki University - also for the purpose of forwarding such information in the future,
- The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Art. 6 section 1e of the GDPR, according to the Act of 20 July 2018 Law on Higher Education and Research, and the university aims to conduct scientific activity, shape civic attitudes, as well as participate in social development and the creation of an economy based on innovation; in the event of consent to receive information about conferences and events organized by Kazimierz Wielki University in the future. The basis for data processing is Art. 6 section 1a of the GDPR. As for the consent, you can withdraw your consent at any time, which does not affect the lawfulness of the data processed prior to its withdrawal,
- We do not intend to reveal your personal data to other entities, except for entities authorized by generally applicable law,
- We do not intend to reveal your data to authorities or residents of third countries (i.e. Non-Members of the EU) or international organizations,
- The personal data you provided, processed in connection with your participation in the Conference, will be processed for the duration of storing of financial, accounting and reporting documentation relating to this event by the University,
- You have the right to request the data administrator to access, rectify, delete, limit processing, and transfer your personal data as well as the right to request its cessation,
- You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority; The supervisory body is, in this case, the Director of the Personal Data Protection Office,
- Providing your data is voluntary, but necessary to achieve the purposes for which it was collected, without providing it, you will not be able to participate in the Conference,
- We do not intend to use your personal data to perform any automated decision-making or profiling.

In addition, we would like to inform you that in order to document the Conference, there will be photos taken during the event, which will be published on the websites belonging to the Kazimierz Wielki University in Bydgoszcz.

CONSENT CLAUSE

(organization of future conferences and events by UKW)
